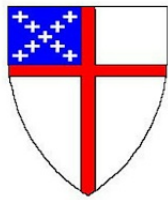

Feeding the Hungry--Right Here at Emmanuel Episcopal Church

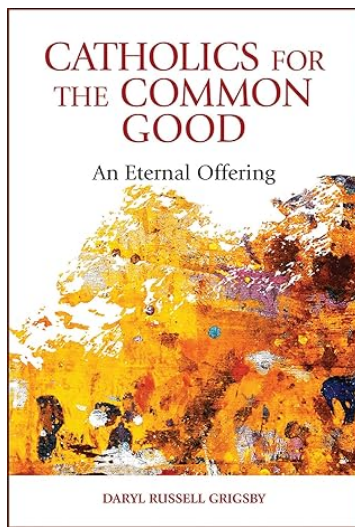

Daryl Grigsby Book Presentation

Daryl Grigsby will be discussing his latest book, 'Catholics For the Common Good: An Eternal Offering', on May 1st at Buck Hall. The book highlights 36 contemporary Catholics who have worked for justice and human dignity in recent times. While the focus is on Catholics, the Introduction makes clear that people of faith have made major contributions to human welfare. Further, there is a focus on Christianity's multi-racial and global nature, as White Americans, African-Americans, Hispanics, and individuals from Brazil, India, El Salvador, France and other nations are featured in the book.

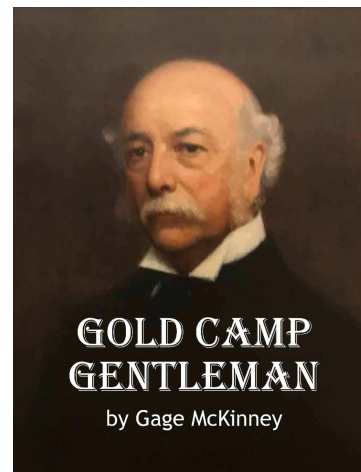
Among those we learn about are Sister Norma Pimentel in the Rio Grande Valley, Dr. Lena Edwards of New Jersey, Father Rutilio Grande of El Salvador, and Archbishop Raymond Hunthausen of Seattle. Their stories of faith, human solidarity and mercy are written to inspire us all to continue to make positive contributions to our society.

Daryl is on the Board of Directors of Color Me Human Nevada County, the Sierra Nevada Memorial Hospital, and FutureChurch. He is also on the Board of Leadership Foundations, a faith-based group meeting critical needs among vulnerable populations in over 50 cities around the world. Daryl also volunteers for Get On the Bus, an organization that connects children with their incarcerated parents in various California prisons.

Daryl is also a regular contribution to the local Union newspaper, as well as National Catholic Reporter and Black Catholic Messenger.

Gage McKinney Presentation of New Book

On June 5th at 5:00pm in Buck Hall, Gage will speak about his new book, *Gold Camp Gentleman: A Life of James D. Hague*, who owned Grass Valley's North Star mine and worshipped at Emmanuel Church. In the age of railroads, Mr. Hague lived a bi-coastal life, dividing his time between New York and Grass Valley. He uncovered a bonanza and created livelihoods for generations of local families. He was also a devout Christian with scientific interests. In this talk, Gage will especially explore Mr. Hague's spiritual life. 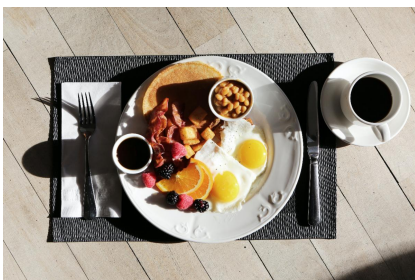

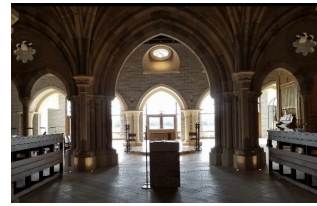
Celebrating Emmanuel's 170th Anniversary With A Cookbook
