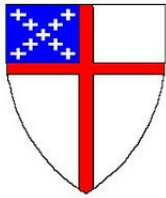

Stewardship 2026 Update

As of last Sunday, we have received 58 giving forms totaling \$242,620 in pledges and \$32,435 in Endowment Fund Loan

Repayment. This is out of 190 mailings. Pledge amounts received are up by 14%. Thank you to those that have turned in a pledge form.

Last years, we ended our stewardship campaign with 72 pledges totaling \$282,000. Based on that, there are about 14 (19%) we have not heard from and we hope to receive.



We really need to hear from the parish, as the Vestry needs to determine a budget going into 2026.

Keep in mind, your pledge is an estimate. Things happen and we understand if you are not able to fulfill this pledge.

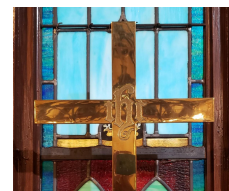


Tuesday Evening Meal (Pioneer Park Ministry @ Trinity)
